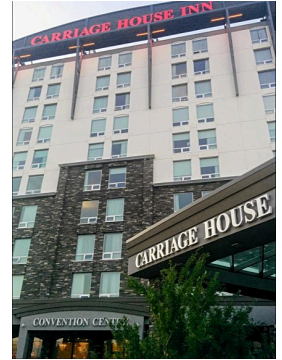

The Carriage House Inn, situated in southwest Calgary, is the venue where Convention 2019 will be held from May 26th thru May 28th. The hotel has convenient access to restaurants, shopping, and more.

The warm, stylish rooms are equipped with work desks, flat screen TV's and mini-fridges, plus free Wi-Fi. Room service is available.

The hotel offers free parking, two restaurants, sports bars and a cocktail lounge, as well as a heated year-round outdoor pool and a 24 hour fitness centre. Other amenities include air-conditioning, laundry service, and a business center. There is a kosher bakery on the premises.

The special Pomegranate Guild Convention room rates, per night (*in Canadian dollars*) are as follows:

Standard Room (2 Double beds or 2 Queen beds)	\$139.00
Premium Queen (1 or 2 Queen beds)	\$149.00
Premium King (1 King bed)	\$159.00
Executive King (1 King bed in oversize room)	\$179.00
Suite	\$289.00

Room rate is for single or double occupancy, no extra charge for 2nd person.

The special room rates are guaranteed for up to 3 days before and 3 days following the dates of Convention, subject to availability. ***Please specify that you are attending the Pomegranate Guild Convention 2019 when you make your reservations.***

The **cut-off date** to reserve rooms at the Convention rate is **Wednesday, April 24, 2019**, again, subject to availability. We strongly urge everyone to book well in advance of that date!

Fly into Calgary International Airport. Rental cars are available at the airport, and taxis are readily accessible. The cost of a taxi to the hotel is approximately \$60.00 (Canadian)

The PGJN Convention 2019 preliminary schedule is: First registration Saturday evening, May 25th. (Shabbat ends late, but Rimon Calgary members will be on hand to assist you); then Sunday morning registration, followed by our trip to Heritage Park Historical Village to experience Calgary's largest outdoor quilt show, to visit our "Little Synagogue on the Prairie", as well as many other buildings and establishments of the early 1900's era in Alberta. Workshops will be held on Monday and Tuesday.

Anyone arriving prior to May 25th who would like to be hosted for Shabbat, please let us know and we will make the arrangements. There is much to see and do in Calgary, and all of Alberta. Consider coming early and/or staying on after the Convention. We will be sending more information in upcoming communications.
